

1 Acclimate materials – Make sure you place the material in the location in which they will be installed for at least 24 hours prior to installation.


Clean the floor – floor must be swept clean of any dust and debris that would prevent the boards from installing flat or adhering to the floor.



Apply 3/8" bead of subfloor adhesive that meets the specification APA AFG-01 (such as Liquid Nails or PL400) in the pattern shown in the graphic.

Make sure you do not butt the boards up to one another; leave a gap for expansion between adjoining boards about the thickness of a paint stirrer.


Leave a gap of 3/8" at walls.

5 Joints must be staggered.

6 Use threaded nails or coarse threaded screws and follow the pattern that is shown.









7 Drive 1" threaded nails or coarse threaded screws straight into subfloor, but not through the subfloor.



- 8 Glue and fastener pattern for 4' x 4' panels required for certain applications.
- 9 Please make sure to read our installation **instructions** related to your type of finished floor, as 440 SoundBarrier installation procedures vary.
